Quinns Districts Netball Club Commitment

Quinns Districts Netball Club is committed to developing our junior members who wish to pursue coaching opportunities within our club. This is facilitated through trainee coaching under the guidance of an experienced coach; Junior Assistant coaching alongside a senior coach; and progressing to Senior Coaching when age and experience dictates.

We want to allow members that love netball, every opportunity to be involved at all levels of the game.

Trainee Coach

- A Trainee Assistant coach is to be aged a minimum of 13 years or above.
- A Trainee Assistant coach must commit to all pre-season and post season coaches sessions, facilitated by QDNC and JNA.
- A Trainee Assistant coach must not run drills without a senior coach present and involved.
- A senior coach must be present at all times during training and game time.
- Trainee coach should be given regular feedback from their senior coach so as to improve their skills to progress to Junior Assistant coach when age and experience dictates.
- A Trainee Assistant Coach must complete the online Netball WA Foundation Course. The Club will reimburse costs on the successful completion and with a commitment from the junior assistant coach to coach for the club for a minimum of two consecutive years.
- A Trainee Assistant Coach must familiarise themselves with all club policies and Code of Conduct.
- A Trainee Assistant Coach will be provided a club uniform that must be worn at all games.
- A Trainee Assistant Coach must commit to be available to attend all training and game days, where possible.

Junior Assistant Coach

- A Junior Assistant Coach must commit to attend all pre and post season coaches sessions, facilitated by QDNC and JNA.
- A Junior Assistant Coach to be aged a minimum of 15 years or above.
- A Junior Assistant Coach may run drills and warm ups but are not to be coaching alone with a team. An adult Coach, Team Manager or Committee member (over the age of 18 years) must always be in attendance with the junior assistant coach and players.

- A Junior Assistant Coach must complete the online Netball WA Foundation Course. The Club will reimburse costs on the successful completion and commitment from the junior assistant coach to coach for the club for a minimum of two consecutive years.
- A Junior Assistant Coach must familiarise themselves with all club policies and Code of Conduct.
- A Junior Assistant Coach will be provided a club uniform that must be worn at all games.
- A Junior Assistant Coach must commit to be available to attend all training and game days, where possible.

Any junior member wishing to pursue a role of trainee or junior assistant coach, needs to apply to QDNC via application form to the committee for consideration.

The QDNC Development Coordinator will attend team training a minimum of two times throughout the season to check on the progress of all Trainee and Junior assistant coaches and provide feedback to the committee.
