Quinns Districts Netball Club believes in giving all children the chance to show leadership skills at junior level and working towards giving them the tools to lead in senior levels be all and beyond.

Captain Selection Policy

Ages 6U – 12U

- Captains should be rotated throughout season. Managers will draw up a roster for new captain on a weekly basis to evenly distribute the role for the season.
- Captain's family will supply fruit/lollies and a scorer/timer. That plyer will be the captain for the day and fulfill all of the captains duties

Ages 13U – 17U

Quinns Districts Netball Club recommend using the rotation method from earlier age groups. This is the preferred captain policy to provide a chance for all players to show leadership.

- A coach may choose to have a fixed captain and vice-captain in these age groups, using the below guide.
 - Captain and vice-captain are to be chosen by players in the team.
 - All players will have the opportunity to vote.
 - Votes will be made on a 3-2-1 basis with 3 votes for the top choice.
 - Votes to be counted by two parents, one of which will be the coach or manager.
 - A captain and vice-captain should be appointed to cover illness or injury.
 - Managers will still provide a separate roster for scorer/timer and fruit/lollies duties.

Any complaints or queries about the captain appointment within a team can be directed in writing to the President, Vice President or suitable committee member on the QDNC committee.
